Objective of the plan:

Ensure the safety of students of determination in emergency situations, and ensure their evacuation in a safe and rapid manner in coordination with the administrative and educational staff.

Emergency Team:

- Identify an evacuation officer for each group of students.
- Training teachers and supervisors to deal with people of determination during evacuation.

Classification of students by type of disability:

- Mobility disability: They need wheelchairs or mobility assistance.
- Hearing impairment: They need visual cues or a signal interpreter.
- Visual impairment: They need escorts to help them move.
- Intellectual disability: they need clear and direct guidance.

Equipping facilities:

- Provide wide and barrier-free walkways.
